Dear Volunteer Participant,

The York Township Volunteer Program returns for its 21th year, and I hope to see you back! If you are receiving this packet, you were registered for last year's program. To allow for us to offer the 2026 Volunteer Program, some changes were required, so please read all paperwork carefully!

This year's program will continue with the inclusion of the Participation Pledge. Please read this and the rules over carefully as both a Parent/Guardian and the Volunteer. Parents/Guardians are fully responsible to address all the information with the Volunteer.

Enclosed is a form for early registration. This early registration period is first come, first serve for Volunteers who were registered in 2025. Early registration will begin on Monday, March 2 (you can drop forms in the box outside the Township Office) and end on Tuesday, March 31. However, starting Friday, March 13 this program will be available to any Playground Graduate! Teens may choose the weeks they plan to attend. First week tuition and registration fee must be submitted with the registration form and returned to the Recreation Office. The Township will NOT accept any applications in advance. Please make sure you follow open registration dates provided below. We will have limited space available and teens will be split equally between York Township Park Pavilion 1 and York Township Park Pavilion 2, so don't wait to reserve your spot!

Forms to be returned for registration—Registration Form, Waiver Form, Participant Pledge.

The 2025 program will run for 6 weeks from June 15-July 24, with no camp on July 3. We will continue to meet 3 times a week (Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays) to offer recreational activities, community service, and time with our Summer Playground Program Leaders. The program is open to youth ages 13-16 as of June 15, 2026, no exceptions. Proof from an original birth certificate may be required for verification for any first time York Township Summer Volunteer participants.

Volunteers should be dropped off at their assigned pavilion to assist with Playground activities on Mondays. On Wednesdays and Fridays, parents/guardians should drop your teen off by 9:00 am at the York Township Park Building.

If you miss your special early registration period or know of another teen interested in the program, open registration will be held on the following dates:

1. March 2-31 for 2025 returning Volunteers, with March 13 for 2025 Playground Graduates.
2. April 1-15 for new Volunteers. **This time period is for York Township residents only.**
3. April 15 until camp week for any new Volunteer, regardless of residency.
4. Forms will be available in the Recreation Office beginning late February and can be dropped off Monday-Friday 7:30 am-4:00 pm in the office.

We understand that at the time of scheduling there are a number of uncertainties, however, we still have an awesome and exciting program planned for teens! Look forward to seeing everyone this summer!

- **Orientation Meeting—**There will be NO orientation meeting for the Volunteer Program. Parents/guardians are responsible to review all information/expectations with your Volunteer. If you have any questions prior to the start of the program, please contact the Recreation Department.

- **Program Days—**Each week, the Volunteers will meet at their assigned York Township Park Pavilion on Mondays to assist with the Playground Program. Wednesdays and Fridays, the Volunteers will meet at the York Township Park Building for a mix of volunteer activities and fun day activities. **No camp July 3.**

Remember—Volunteers must participate during the Playground Program and volunteer days to be eligible for fun day activities or pay an additional fee. Too many Volunteers are not participating on these days and are only coming for the fun days. This is acknowledged in the Participation Pledge that we are asking a parent and the Volunteer to sign. All Volunteers are responsible for tracking their own volunteer hours during the program and a Volunteer Counselor can sign any necessary paperwork. Volunteer hours are only hours when a teen is volunteering (not travel time or fun days).

- **Program Times—**Typical hours are Mondays/ Wednesdays/Fridays from 9:00am – 3:30pm. However, the hours may change to accommodate activities (start earlier, run later). **Please refer to the late pickup policy.**
- **Program Location—**On Mondays, parents will drop teens at their assigned York Township Park Pavilion to assist with the Playground Program. They should arrive by 9:00am for a brief meeting with the Playground Counselors. Volunteers are expected to assist the counselors with check-in, set up for activities, oversee activities, etc. On Wednesdays/Fridays, parents will drop-off the Volunteer by 9:00am at the York Township Park Building. Pickup should be no later than 3:30pm (unless otherwise stated) at same place as drop-off. Also, activities may start earlier or run later than typical. Volunteers will be notified when these adjustments occur.
- **Volunteer Sites and Field Trips—** Staff is preparing these schedules based on activities from the past and will have arrangements (admissions, transportation, etc.) completed before the program starts. This is why accurate registration, cancellations, and payment for registered weeks is important. Please note, for the safety of your Volunteer, drop-off/pick up at a Volunteer or Fun Day site will not be allowed, so please plan accordingly.
- **Other Waivers/Forms—**Additional waivers may be required for fields trips and will be handed out at the beginning of the week. Other additional forms must be signed by a parent/guardian; late pick up policy, etc. The Participation Pledge details the Volunteer's willingness to participate in the activities scheduled each week and the disciplinary actions that will be taken if the Volunteer chooses not to participate once at the site or displays disruptive/abusive behavior.
- **You only pay for the week(s) for which you register.** You may register for only one week for **\$65 residents/\$75 non-residents (+ \$35 nonrefundable one-time administration fee and t-shirt)** or you may register for the whole 6-week program (including administration fee and t-shirt) for only \$425 for York Township residents and for \$485 for non-York Township residents. The choice is yours. Administration fee **and** first week payment is due upon registering. By requiring registration for each week, we are able to provide accurate counts for activities and an accurate list with which we can check in/out our Volunteers. **If you have indicated your attendance for a week, we will expect payment for that week unless we receive notice. Payment is due to the Recreation Office the TUESDAY prior to the week attending. Cancellations MUST BE MADE to the Recreation Department by emailing recdept@yorktownshippa.gov ONLY. Cancellations should not be made to the counselors. ALL CANCELLATIONS MUST BE MADE by the Tuesday prior to the week attending or you will be responsible for that weeks' payment.**
- **Clothing—Volunteers should wear their CURRENT YEAR program t-shirt (included in registration fee) on all Playground Program Days and Volunteer Days.** Volunteers should also wear sneakers as you will be working/playing with the kids and doing projects. Flip flops, sandals and short-shorts are not acceptable on Playground Program Days and Volunteer Days. Clothing for Fun Days should be appropriate for the activity planned for the day. Limited shirt sizes will be available following May 15.

1. Registration fee and at least the first Session fee must be paid at time of registration.
2. There are no discounts for multiple teens.
3. This program will be capped at 12 teens per week.
4. At this time, teens will need to bring a non-refrigerated/non-microwaveable lunch and drink with them each day (in a cooler bag would be good to keep the lunch and drink cool). Situations may vary each week regarding lunch opportunities, so teens will be notified if they do not need to bring a lunch.
5. Some days may be swapped (for example—fun day on Wednesday instead of Friday) to fit in with other schedules (volunteer sites, playground program activities), see calendar.
6. Volunteers are expected to participate on volunteer day and playground day to be eligible for fun day activity.
7. Each Volunteer and his/her parent must sign the Volunteer Participation Pledge prior to beginning the program.

VOLUNTEEN PARTICIPATION PLEDGE

The Volunteer Program is designed to give teens the opportunity to realize the value of volunteering to his/her community by providing time to work with our Playground Program and to do service projects in the area on a weekly basis. While we hope the teen is able to see the value of helping others (often others less fortunate than himself/herself) in the community without receiving anything in return, the Department is willing to show appreciation to the teen for volunteering by planning a fun activity for the week.

However, many teens are simply not putting in the time to deserve the fun day. So, the Department has implemented the following Participation Pledge to make sure that all VOLUNTEENS AND PARENTS understand what is required when registering for this program and what will happen if the volunteer time is not put in during the week. No teen may participate until this pledge is received by the office.

Finally, teens are able to understand and follow direction without being repeatedly told the same thing over and over again. If they cannot, or exhibit unacceptable behavior, then discipline will follow as outlined below.

Please read and sign the following pledge and return it to the office.

As a Volunteer, I pledge to:

OVERALL

- LISTEN TO AND FOLLOW the directions of the Volunteer Program Coordinators at all times, especially when the group is onsite for a volunteer project or attending a fun day activity.
- PERSONAL CELL PHONES are used for an EMERGENCY ONLY. **NO CELL PHONES WILL BE PRESENT, AT ANY POINT, WHEN VOLUNTEERING.** If I do, I understand that it will be held by staff until the end of the day. I understand that I am fully responsible for my personal cell phone and will not hold York Township responsible for damaged, lost or stolen property. The staff have phones available for all other purposes.
- BE CONSIDERATE to all others involved in the Volunteer Program, the Playground Program, and the public in general. This includes all physical and verbal behavior. I understand that the Volunteer Program Coordinators and Playground Counselors WILL NOT TOLERATE any physical abuse, verbal bullying, and/or offensive language towards staff, counselors, other teens/campers, or public persons in the area. I understand that my discipline will be as follows, depending on the severity of my actions:

For Physical Abuse

- First Warning—depending on the severity of the abuse, discipline could range from verbal warning (with written notice to parent) to removal for the remainder of the week and/or immediate removal from the remainder of the program.
- Second Warning—discipline will build upon action taken during first warning. If verbal warning given, then it will be followed by immediate removal for the remainder of the week. If teen had previously been removed for a portion of a week, then it will be followed by immediate removal from the remainder of the program.
- Third Warning—immediate removal from the remainder of the program.

For Verbal Bullying/Offensive Language

- First Warning—verbal reprimand from staff with written notice to parent.
- Second Warning—immediate removal for the day.
- Third Warning—immediate removal from the remainder of the program.

For Disregard for Staff Instructions/Refusal to Participate

- First Warning—verbal reprimand from staff with written notice to parent.
- Second Warning—removal from group (time-out with time deducted from service time), plus one-hour automatic deduction from service time.
- Third Warning—removal from the remainder of the program.

- NEVER BRING A WEAPON on any day of the program or MAKE A WEAPON while at the program. This will result in immediate dismissal from the program and a possible report to the local authorities.

VOLUNTEEN PARTICIPATION PLEDGE (continued)

- PARTICIPATE in at least 90% of the time allotted for volunteer hours to the Playground Program and the Volunteer service project for each week that I am registered. If I do not participate at this level, I understand that the following will occur:
 - I will not be allowed to attend the fun day for the week and no refund for the week will be given.
 - If the fun day happens BEFORE the Volunteer service project and I attend the fun day and do not complete the time needed for the volunteer hours, then an additional fee could be charged. The fee will be due before I may attend any following Volunteer weeks for which I am registered.
 - If this happens more than once (without prior permission for absence, such as for doctor's appointments), then I could be removed from the program for any following weeks for which I am registered.

DURING THE PLAYGROUND PROGRAM

- BE ON TIME when arriving at the Playground Program on Monday mornings to assist in setting up for the day's activities.
- LISTEN TO AND FOLLOW the directions of the Playground Counselors as they work to coordinate activities for the Playground campers.
- BE INVOLVED in the Playground activities and interact with the campers. I understand that if I am not participating, then it will affect my ability and/or the cost to go on the fun days. I also understand that my lack of involvement could result in me being removed from the program.

DURING THE VOLUNTEER PROJECTS

- LISTEN TO AND FOLLOW the directions of any staff from the volunteer site that is directing us in the work to do.
- PARTICIPATE in the volunteer project(s) scheduled for the week that I am attending. I understand that if I am not participating, then it will affect my ability and/or the cost to go on the fun days. I also understand that my lack of involvement could result in me being removed from the program.

As a Volunteer Parent, I pledge to:

- REVIEW the Volunteer Participation Pledge with my teen so that he/she understands what is involved by participating in this program.
- PROVIDE notification of any time that my teen may miss service hours due to doctor's appointments, etc., and provide note from doctor accordingly.
- BE ACCOUNTABLE for making sure my teen is on time and at the proper locations as noted in the calendar.
- BE AVAILABLE OR HAVE SOMEONE AVAILABLE to pick up my child as necessary due to any disciplinarian actions.
- UNDERSTAND that I will not receive any refunds for any week in which my teen has attended a portion of the week but was then removed from the program due to lack of participation and/or disciplinary actions. I understand that refunds will be given for any future weeks for which my teen was registered after his/her removal.

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Late Pick-up Policy

Parents of participants enrolled in York Township's Summer Volunteer Program will be charged \$1.00 per minute/per child, **based on a York Township timed device**, for the program pick-up times.

- If you know you are going to be late, please notify the counselors so they can let your child know. **Late fee will still be charged**.
- If a parent or authorized pick-up person does not arrive or call by 5 minutes past the designated pick-up time, staff will assume an emergency exists and will begin to call emergency contacts for your child.
- If no emergency contact can be reached within 1-hour past designated pick-up time, staff may contact the York County Regional Police Department who will pick up the child.
- **Late fees must be paid within three business days. Late fees can be paid at the Recreation Office.**
- Continued disregard for the pick-up time or failure to pay late pick-up fees can be cause for your child's termination from the program.
- If you arrive after 3:30 pm, **based on a York Township timed device**, you will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per minute per child after 3:30 pm.

It is very important to have updated contact information in your child's file at all times. Any child who is not picked up will be under the supervision of a counselor or Camp Director until the parent, emergency contact, or the authorities arrive. All information about the incident will be discussed directly with the parent or guardian and never with the child.

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REMINDERS

- **WEEKLY FEE**—Each week must be paid by **TUESDAY** of the prior week attending.

Payment can be mailed in or dropped off at the Township building either in the office or the outside drop box. Please indicate Volunteer name and week you are paying for on any envelope/paperwork.

- **SHOES/CLOTHES**—**Volunteers must wear current year program t-shirt when working with the playground program or on volunteer days.** Sneakers should be worn as you will be working/playing with the kids. Flip flops, sandals, and short-shorts are not acceptable! Fun Day clothing should be appropriate for that days activities.

- **LUNCHES**—Volunteers should pack a lunch on all days unless otherwise indicated on the calendar. Lunches should be in throw-away bags or insulated coolers and non-refrigerated and non-microwavable.

- **FUN DAYS**—Admissions for Fun Day activities are included in the weekly fee. In case of inclement weather, staff will plan an alternate activity.

- **FUN DAY REFUNDS**—There are no refunds if your child chooses to not participate in the activity. We plan a variety of activities and hope that you would encourage your child to try new things.

- **DROPPING OFF/PICKING UP**—Please refer to the schedule to determine where and when you should drop off your Volunteer. The typical schedule is Mondays—assigned pavilion; Wednesdays and Fridays—YT Park Building. Any transportation needed throughout the day will be provided by staff and Volunteers will be brought back to the YT Park Building no later than 3:30 pm unless told otherwise (see schedule). Late pick up fees may apply.
- **WORKING WITH PLAYGROUND**—Volunteers will have a brief staff meeting Monday mornings with Playground staff. Volunteers are expected to assist Playground staff in daily activities.
